- 50% of Waitlist Applicants Accept
 - 7% Get Accommodated

State of Good Repair

- Capital Projects – Asset Mgmt Grp
- Rinks, Fieldhouses, Playgrounds, Tennis Courts - 5 Year Interval
 - Impacted by Pandemic
 - \$1 Billion in Backlog
- Tennis Courts, Parking Lots Backlogged
 - 2024-2033 – 10 Year Plan
 - 2026 Next Audit of Courts
 - Rerecords Database Being Reconstructed
- Clubs Making Larger Reserves Taking on Responsibility for Full Rehabilitation

Member Expulsion

- Frequent Topic
- Adherence to Suspension and Ban Policy Required
- City GM Uses by interval (6 Months, 1 Year, 2 Years etc..)
- Revoke Membership (Does Not Apply to Public Time)
- Don't Use "Suspend" or "Ban"
